Please join TIWA and our esteemed guest speaker as we explore the topic of Earthquake Risk in Eastern Canada.

Earthquakes can inflict heavy loss of life and damage to property and infrastructures, deeply disrupting communities. However, the peril is not easily predicted, can strike in seconds and is not in people's minds.

This is especially true in eastern Canada, where there is a general lack of awareness about earthquake risk and earthquake insurance. Earthquakes in the east tend to be of lower magnitude than in the west, but their loss-inflicting potential, particularly in southern Quebec and eastern Ontario, is huge. The two seismic zones cover an area that is home to most of the east's population and concentration of economic assets.

This presentation will shed some light on the topic and illustrate some potential means to address the situation.
